



Pompeii Uncovered, Vesuvius Uncorked: History & Wine combined

Step straight into the streets of ancient Pompeii with a private archaeologist-guide who brings to life villas, bathhouses and frescoes frozen in time by Vesuvius' eruption. As you walk, you can almost hear the echoes of daily life in this once-bustling city.

You learn about their volcanic-soil vines and sustainable growing techniques, tour the cellars, and then sit down to a long, relaxed lunch.

Under a pergola of grapevines, you enjoy traditional Campanian dishes paired with a tasting of their wines – sparkling, white, orange, and red – each one telling its own story of the land. It's a beautiful introduction to the warmth, flavours, and hospitality that define this region.

After lunch, your driver continues the journey along the coast or back towards your accommodation.
